We are delighted to announce that our applications for BBC Gardeners' World Fair Spring at Beaulieu Estate in Hampshire for 2022 are now open! In its first year the Spring show was a sell out and we are very excited to continue the show into its second year.

The Spring Fair at Beaulieu is set amidst the internationally famous National Motor Museum, Palace House and atmospheric culinary gardens.

Awards – BBC Gardeners' World Fair Spring 2022:

Each exhibitor will be asked to present a display in front of their stands using pallets provided by the show. We ask that you create an artistic display using a collection of different sized containers to illustrate by example, your plant specialisms. The plants in the display should reflect the varieties of plants which you have available in your sales area and should be of high show quality.

The displays will be assessed taking into account the quality of the plants, the artistic design and the overall effect. The three best staged will receive prize money as follows:

Award	Prizemoney
1 st Place	£450
2 nd Place	£250
3 rd Place	£100

Access and Storage

The daily storage is located behind your stand. We will be screening the storage from visitor view in between each stand with either heavy duty hessian or bamboo. There will be enough storage behind your stand for approx. 7 trolleys. The site is secure, and every reasonable measure will be taken to ensure protection of exhibitors' stock and materials. However, the Organisers cannot be responsible for the security of exhibitors' possessions or stock.

Plant Porters and Plant Creche

There will be a Plant Creche available on site for visitors to leave their plant purchases. With the addition of porters running a wheelbarrow shuttle service to the visitor car parks.

Plant Health and Regulations

Imported plants which appear on DEFRA's list of Xylella susceptible plants should not be sold or shown, although UK raised plants will be acceptable. Exhibitors will also be expected to adhere to the Non-Native Invasive Plants regulations and to ensure that all imported plants are labelled with the necessary Plant Passport information.

Sales Plants

All sales plants must be well rooted in their own pot and labelled to show both the genus and variety. The plants must be of good specimen without pests or diseases and true to type. All pots (or unit planters) must carry the contact details of the vendor.

SECTION 4: AUTUMN DISPLAY AND STAGING:

In the spirit of being sustainable, if you have your own 1.2m x 1.2m pallet we welcome exhibitors to bring these to the show. The pallets must be in good condition and for continuity of displays we ask that exhibitors use 2 pallets stacked on top of each other. If you are booking one of the larger marquees or have larger plants to display, we ask that you use 4 pallets stacked 2 tall side by side.

Criteria for assessing the display will be issued 8 weeks before the show.

Staging:

We ask that exhibitors use trestle tables in good condition covered with oatmeal hessian to stage their plants within the curtilage of the exhibitor's marquee area. We have trestle tables and hessian available to order prior to the show but again welcome exhibitors to use their own. Trestle table form will be in the exhibitor manual
